ROBERT F. HAND. Before your report No. 104943 is submitted to the Committee I have to request that you will state whether there are any steam pipes over 3" bore, and if so whether they have been examined and tested.

EDITH PURDY. With reference to your report No. 104951, it is noted that the boiler was examined internally in January 1947, and it is concluded it has now been re-examined and no deterioration found in view of the survey date of 12.47 recommended by you, but I shall be glad to receive your confirmation on this point before submitting your report to the Committee.
