YOUR YARD NOS. 368/9.

We return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 16th ultimo, showing proposed support and stiffening of deck and winch platforms for the above mentioned vessels: and in reply have to say that the scantlings and arrangements as shown and amended thereon will be approved, provided they be carried out to our satisfaction.

It is observed that the watertight bulkhead on frame 106 is now to be omitted and only a partial bulkhead fitted. As the length of these ships is such as to require (by Section 17) five watertight bulkheads to be fitted, the Owners' consent should be obtained to the omission of this bulkhead, and the following notation will be made in the Register Book:-

"Intermediate BH dispensed with; 4 BH".

The remaining copy of the plan is being retained for record together with plan of rigging, forwarded by you for reference.
