Reverting to your letter of the 21st July last and subsequent correspondence, I have to inform you that the Society's Surveyors at Piraeus have now reported the General Examination of the hull and machinery held in July last.

As a result of the satisfactory nature of the report received, the Committee have now confirmed their agreement to the Special Survey being postponed until the end of October, 1958.

The screwshaft, previously reported pitted in way of the keyway, was examined on this occasion, but it was recommended that it should be further specially examined by the end of next month, and the Committee have continued the class subject to this matter receiving attention by that time. A record of Docking Survey 7,58 has been assigned.
