I acknowledge your letter of the 24th instant which has been read to the Committee today.

They have given long and careful consideration to your comments and have finally decided to agree in this instance to the Owners' request for maintenance of class until 7th October, provided the Owners arrange for a General Examination to be made of the ship afloat, and she be found in a satisfactory condition for this extension. It is concluded such examination can be held before the end of July at Marseilles, but should the matter receive attention at another port, it will also be necessary to obtain the Marseilles Surveyors' concurrence to this postponement, bearing in mind that recent surveys on her have all been held at that port.

This decision carries with it authorisation to the Surveyors to issue a short term Loadline Certificate, valid until 7th October, provided the requisite Loadline Survey is held, and as the existing Certificate will expire on the 19th July, it is concluded the Owners will wish to hold the survey before then.

In conveying this decision to you, the Committee have asked me to say they hope this will be an isolated case, and will not be treated as a precedent, for they are still of opinion that
