QUESTION.

I shall be glad if you remind the Owners that the Line Certificate of this vessel will expire on the 31st of December and let me know what arrangements they propose making to carry out the necessary special survey.

I have also to point out that the present "Examined" condition will expire at the end of December when a Special Survey will become due.

I also think it well to refer to the memorandum of the 14th of October respecting the main high injection valve chest.

ANSWER.

Date:— 25th November, 1947.

We are advised by the Owners that this vessel is now laid up at this port and is being prepared for Special Survey, which together with the Load Line Survey, will be held before being recommissioned.

They also state that the main high sea injection valve chest will be renewed when the vessel enters drydocks for the purpose of the Special Survey.
