Subject:- S/Ss "CORINTHIA" & "IONIA".

The Greek Shipping Committee, London, advise us that General Examination and Boiler Survey Certificates S/S "IONIA" expire on 25/26th October, 1944 and the Survey Certificate falls due on 22nd October, 1944. Also the Hull, Machinery, Part of Boilers and Condition Survey Certificate of S/S "CORINTHIA" expire on 28th September, 1944.

2. As these vessels owing to Operational requirements being Royal Hellenic Navy Auxiliaries - cannot be immobilised for survey etc., it is requested that the validity of their above mentioned certificates may be extended as long as possible.


3. For your guidance, these vessels have always remained in Malta, under the supervision of the competent Authorities and have always been kept in a very efficient condition.
