We thank you for your letter of 19th inst. from which we note the position regarding the surveys of these vessels whilst they are in the service of the Greek Government under a Charter similar to the British Charter T.98. We presume that this does not mean that the vessels lose your Classification, and we shall be glad if you will confirm this to us. In the meantime we have telegraphed to our agents in Alexandria as follows:

"Yours sixteenth Greek Government responsible for surveys under Charter T.98 stop reasonable postponement permissible but you must see that vessels not neglected stop surveys and necessary repairs should be effected soonest by and for account Government and vessels maintained best possible condition".
