Dear Sirs,

I duly received your cablegram of the 16th instant respecting the steamers "CORINTHIA" and "IONIA" and in reply have to say that as these vessels are now purely naval units under a Charter similar to T.98, all maintenance work comes under Admiralty jurisdiction and not that of Lloyd's Register.

In such cases it is the custom for the particulars of class to remain undisturbed in the Register Book pending redelivery to original Owners, but I have to add that in the event of a request being received from the local Admiralty Authorities, you will be in order in carrying out any inspection work that may be required by them.
