This vessel was built in 1911 and is classed 100A1. She has two continuous decks with combined poop and bridge, also a forecastle, and holds a passenger certificate.

The Piraeus Surveyors forward, at the request of the Owners, three plans, also specification, in triplicate, shewing the proposed arrangements for converting the vessel from coal to oil burning. These arrangements include the fitting of a deep tank forward of the boiler space and wing settling tanks, the total capacity of ^{all the tanks here} which is about 550 tons.

It is submitted the Surveyors be informed that the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended will be approved provided they be carried out to their satisfaction.

They should also be informed by wire as follows :-

"PLANS PROPOSED CONVERSION TO OIL BURNING STOP GIRDER TO
"BE FITTED ON FORE AND AFT BULKHEADS OTHERWISE ARRANGEMENTS
"APPROVED GENERALLY WITH MINOR MODIFICATIONS PARTICULARLY
