"DASHWOOD", 2156 tons gross of London, whilst lying on the pontoon at Sunderland. A general examination and freeboard survey have been carried out and a report will be forwarded to the Committee recommending that the vessel be classed 100A1 (Class contemplated), with the notation Examined L.R. 4.47.(12 mths.), subject to the damaged shell plating etc., on starboard side aft being repaired at the first convenient opportunity.

The freeboards have been verified and the markings are as follows:-
