

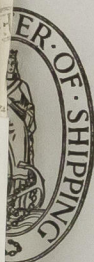

permanently repaired at next Special Survey and to all other conditions
at present attached to the ship's class being dealt with as previously
recommended
being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes.

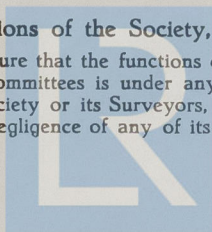
