

Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 9th September last respecting the Steamers "NIKOBAR" ex "RUSHVILLE VICTORY" and "SERAMPORÉ" ex "AMHERST VICTORY", I have to acquaint you that as previously intimated certain queries were raised through the New York Office with the Society's Surveyors at Baltimore. Satisfactory replies have been received with the exception that the electric cables from the emergency generator sets are stated to be in varnished cambric, having two cables per pole each of 7.024" diameter. This is insufficient for the current produced by these generators and I shall therefore be glad if you will confirm whether in each case there are, in fact, four cables of this size per pole. If so, you will appreciate that the matter is in order.
