Dear Sir,

S. Before Baltimore First Entry Report No. 8492 on the Refrigerating Machinery and Appliances of the S.S. "NIKOBAR" is submitted to the Committee for confirmation, I shall be glad if you will request the Surveyors to confirm the number of refrigerated cargo chambers and their total capacity, also the number of refrigerating units and the number of compressors as the figures given in the body of the report do not agree with those given for insertion in the Register Book.

They should also confirm the total ice melting capacity in tons per 24 hours shown as .75 tons, as from the particulars of the 5 machines furnished it is estimated that this should be 20 tons approximately.

In addition a plan or sketch showing the arrangement of the refrigerated chambers with the capacity of each should be forwarded as the information furnished is not sufficient to estimate the duty of the plant.
