It is submitted ~~the~~ Surveyors be requested to confirm the number of refrigerated cargo chambers and their total capacity; the number of Refrigerating Units and number of compressors. The figures given in the body of the report are not the same as those given as particulars to be entered in the Register Book.

They should also be asked to confirm the total ice melting capacity in tons per 24 hours shown as 75 tons, from the particulars of the five machines furnished it is estimated that this should be 20 tons (approx.).

In addition the Surveyor should be requested to forward a plan or sketch showing the arrangement of the refrigerated chambers with the capacity of each, the information furnished is not sufficient to estimate the duty of the plant.
