that I have Recommended that she be continued as classed without fresh record of survey, the notation of SS (with place and date) being deferred until completion of survey (including repairs to N<sup>o</sup>.4 tween deck frames), and to have notation of "Fitted for O.F. 2,51 F.P. above 150° F." inserted in the Register book at this time,

being fit to carry dry & perishable cargoes. - Cargo battens not fitted

To complete the Special Survey the following remain to be carried out:

To be examined: Bottom & rudder - Chain Cables - Chain Locker.

To be tested: 1) Double bottom tanks Nos. 6 & 7.  
2) Forepeak tank.

To be repaired: Frames of tweendeck N<sup>o</sup>. 4.
