
Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines

Alterations to Accommodation

The 2 steel skid skylights on the after deck, have now been removed and dispensed with, and the deck in way made good.

There are now 2 openings in the fore-castle front with 18" coamings, instead of 1 as shown on the original C. 11. and 12 teakwood doors instead of 6, these are all similar to original construction.

The accommodation for gunners in the after tween decks has now been removed and dispensed with, all portlights & washbasin, & W.C. discharges have been removed and satisfactorily blanked off.
