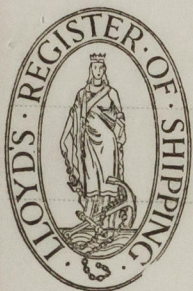

and that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London,
a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my
satisfaction, also that I will Recommend that she be *retained* as classed with
a fresh record of D.S.B. 60, subject to the following shell plates on
starboard side G.4 and F.7 to be faired in place, G.5, F.4, H.7, J.6,
G.7, G.8, G.9, G.10, H.9, J.8 and J.9 to be removed faired and
refitted, H.10, H.11 and H.12 to be renewed. The following shell
plates in port side ^E A.8, ^{H:10} F.10, F.5, G.5, G.4, H.4 and H.3 to be faired
in place J.3 and J.4 to remove faired and refit. F.8 to be renewed. The
above to be carried out before the end of November 1960 and that all
conditions at present attached to the ships class being dealt with as
previously recommended.
