In reply to your letter of the 8th September I have to inform you that the Committee are agreeable to a General Examination being held when the ship is drydocked at Hong Kong at the end of the present month with a view to the postponement of the Special Survey until some time before the end of November, 1962.

It is considered that the Continuous Survey of the machinery should be advanced at the forthcoming drydocking by the inspection of the following items, it being borne in mind that this will not complete the present cycle:-

Main Engine: No.5 cylinder, etc.  
No.4 top end.  
No.7 bottom end.  
No.9 main bearing.  
Attached freshwater cooling pump.


Auxiliaries: Salt water cooling pump.  
Upper feed pump.  
Pumping arrangements.  
Fire extinguishing arrangements.  
Electrical equipment.
