EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR Docking & Condition Surveys.

W. & T. Repairs

Sundry minor repairs effected only.

S.R.L. Item "Bottom shell plating & internals to be specially examined and dealt with at next drydocking". As this phrasing does not indicate the position of the effected plating and no damage other than D7 (stbd. side Nos. from aft) (See S.R.L. addition) was considered necessary to be noted as an S.R.L. item the subject item was retained meantime. The vessel is now proceeding to Hong Kong for breaking up purposes.

S.R.L. Addition

Bottom plate D7 stbd. side numbered from aft noted set up over length of plate (cause and time unknown) but indicative of grounding or refloating). Bilge keel adjacent was also noted to be slightly buckled. No repairs effected at this time but is recommended that D7 (ss Nos. from aft) be specially examined and dealt with at next Special Survey, considered efficient meantime.


