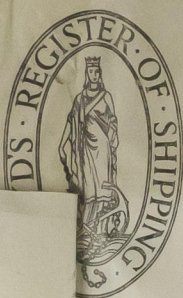

 me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I will
 Recommend that she be retained as classed without fresh record
of survey subject to one bower anchor being placed on board
before the ship proceeds to sea and one bower anchor along with
5 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest
being fit to carry opportunity, and subject to all other conditions
attached to the ships class being dealt with as previously
recommended.
