Remarks of Survey _____

The Middlesbrough Surveyors report this trawler placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated, stream line plating fitted to the rudder post of the sternframe, rudder renewed and minor repairs carried out.

The trawler has been lengthened by about eight feet by fitting a new fore end and a cruiser stern in accordance with approved plans.

15 additional fathoms of chain cable have been supplied and compared with certificate of test to comply with the Rule requirements for figure "1".

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 11,36.
