This vessel was built by Messrs. Cook, Welton & Gemmell, Ltd., in 1929.

The Middlesbrough Surveyors forward six plans, in triplicate, shewing a proposal by Messrs. Smith's Dock Co. to lengthen the vessel at the forward end by 8 feet on the load water line. A cruiser stern is also to be fitted.

A similar proposal was approved by the Committee in October last for the sister ship "AMETHYST".

It is submitted the Surveyors be informed that the scantlings and arrangements as shewn will be approved, provided they be carried out to their satisfaction.

As in the case of the sister vessel "AMETHYST", the existing equipment could be accepted for the increased length, provided an additional 15 fathoms of cable of correct size and weight be supplied.

The Surveyors might be reminded that the examination of such proposals will be facilitated if they make reference in their letter to previous similar proposals dealt with in their district, in this case the "AMETHYST".
