For particulars of service and arrangements for the carrying through of the Annual (Classification) Survey see memo dated 21.2.50 and copy of letter dated 28.2.50 to the Principal Surveyors, Montreal.

It would appear from the attached report (Rpt.10) of Survey held at TUKTOTAKTUK N.W.T. 7.51 by a Squadron Leader of the Royal Canadian Air Force that the requirements of an Annual (Classification) Survey have been generally complied with EXCEPT for the examination of underwater external structure in drydock.

It is noted the report is also signed by the Ship's Master and Chief Engineer and the ship is reported in good condition.

In view of the foregoing being in conformity with the arrangements approved in our letter dated 28.2.50 above referred to, IT IS SUBMITTED the ship is worthy to remain as classed by the British Corporation and to have the Notation of "A.S. 7.51" assigned.
