Please see attached letter from the Owners dated the 14th August 1951.

It would appear from the attached report (Rpt.10) of Survey held at TUKTOYAKTUK. N.W.T. 7.51 by a Squadron Leader of the Royal Canadian Air Force that the requirements of an Annual (Classification) survey have been generally complied with, except for examination of underwater external structure in dry dock.

It is noted the report is also signed by the Ship's Master and Chief Engineer and the ship is reported in good condition.

In view of the foregoing it is recommended the arrangements now proposed by the Owners for postponement of drydocking until the Autumn of 1952 (when the Special Survey due 4.53 will be held) be submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
