
ements agreed ..... In November, 1960 it was stated that the ship was laid up and would probably be broken up. On 5th January, 1961 the ship was still laid up and the Committee agreed to the class remaining undisturbed provided the outstanding surveys are held before the ship again proceeds to sea.

proposal ..... It is now stated that the ship will not be broken up at Curacao but is expected to sail from there about April, 1961 with a cargo of scrap for Germany, probably for sale to German shipbreakers.

Ship 35 years old. Submitted a satisfactory GE (Cir. 1959) be held and any desired period of postponement to be determined by the condition as then found. *JAG 8.2.61.*

G.E (Cir 1959) to be held. If vessel is not broken up in Germany, SPS should be held before entering service again. *8/2/61*
