A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due 11,51 but postponement to 11,52 was approved, subject to a satisfactory General Examination being held.

The class is subject to permanent repairs to indented shell plating (p.s.f.) by completion of the Special Survey.

ACTION and NOTATION of "ss.Aioi - 5,52" are DEFERRED for completion of Special Survey by 11,52.

TO COMPLETE THE SPECIAL SURVEY:-

- No.4 D.B. tank internals and tank top to be permanently repaired.
- Upper deck plating to be partly renewed.

The proposal of the Owners to complete the Special Survey in May next (6 months beyond the expiry date of the year of grace) was not approved by the Committee who requested the KOBE Surveyors to arrange for the Special Survey to be completed by the end of March if the vessel were to retain her class.

The KOBE Surveyors have now cabled this Office stating that the vessel is expected to arrive in Japan in the middle of April for completion of the Survey. They recommend this proposal for approval, stating that the new Owners are "cooperating."
