

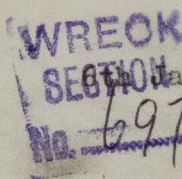

Steamer "INGEROIS"

I acknowledge the receipt of your letters of the 31st December and 2nd January and much regret to find that your telegrams of last month were inadvertently not handed to this department, but were dealt with elsewhere.

When the case was before the Committee last Friday, therefore, they were unaware of the fact that the ship had been sold to Belgium for breaking up. Confirmation has since been received from the Antwerp Surveyors that the work of breaking up has actually been started and the Committee have, therefore, today expunged the class and given instructions for a notation of "Broken up" to be recorded against the ship's name in the Register Book.
