Drillings at ends to be made in the vicinity of the peak bulkheads.

The class is subject to indented side shell plating, etc. in way of No.6 port wing tank being permanently repaired by next drydocking, and to the stem plating being further examined and permanently repaired as necessary by November 1954.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (D) became due 12,53 and was commenced Bmn. 10,53, but postponement of completion of Special Survey until 10,54 was approved 21.1.54 a satisfactory General Examination being held at Bmn. 10,53.

ACTION is DEFERRED for completion of the Special Survey by 10,54.

The BREMEN Surveyors report (3,55), ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated and the outstanding requirements of a SPECIAL SURVEY (D), previously commenced as above, now complied with.

On account of wear and tear repairs effected to bottom and side shell plating, bulkhead and deck plating, framing, floors, transverses, etc.

On account of damage due to various causes repairs effected to side shell plating, etc. (p & s) and to all the deferred items as above.

The thicknesses of shell plating as ascertained by drilling are as stated above and together with the renewals now effected have previously been approved by the London Office.

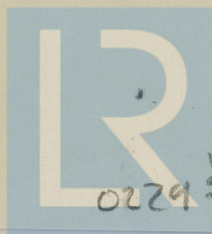
