M. With further reference to Liverpool Report No. 95320, on the freeboards of the steamer "THIRLAND CASTLE", Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co's Yard No. 946, I have to inform you that it is observed that the length on the load waterline is given as 450 feet. It is assumed that this is a clerical error and that the length should be 460 feet.

I have to request that the Surveyors will forward an amended report giving correct dimensions and particulars, and they should be careful to see that the lengths of erections correspond to the length on waterline.

They should give dimensions and full particulars of all the hatchways on both the upper and second decks.
