
This ship was built in 1944.

A SPECIAL SURVEY (C) becomes due 12,61.
She was last examined in dry dock 6,58.

The LONDON Surveyors report the ship examined on the slipway and renewal of 4 keel plates and the complete lower chine plates recommended.

It would appear now that this ship has been towed to Messrs. T. Ward Ltd., Thurrock, to be broken up for scrap metal.

In view of the above it is submitted ACTION be DEFERRED pending further information.
