Dear Sir,

With regard to the correspondence between our London Office and our Amsterdam and Cape Town Offices (copies attached) concerning the Owners proposal to adopt the Continuous Machinery arrangement for the machinery of the whalers, I have just received a further letter from London, as follows:-

"The Committee's acceptance of the Continuous Survey arrangement for this and other Vessels of the Owners Fleet assumed that about 25% of the machinery will be submitted for survey each year and that all parts will be seen in regular rotation.

It is concluded the Owners are aware of this, but as 25% of the machinery in this case is now overdue for survey, we shall be glad if you will ascertain and let us know what arrangements they propose making to bring the survey up to date".

I would be obliged to have an answer to the above.
