This unclassified ex Japanese Whaler was built in 1938. She has been transferred to the Dutch flag and the new Owners desire classification with this Society.

A Special Survey has been held on the machinery and the screwshaft examined. Parts examined have been compared with approved plans and found to comply with the Rule requirements.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the record LMC 9.49

S(CL)N 5.49

"Fitted for oil fuel F.P. above 150°F"

The machinery requirements for the notation "Strengthened for navigation in Ice" have been complied with.

The Surveyors state that a spare propeller of approved material will be placed on board the whale Factory Vessel "WILLEM BARENDZ", and it is concluded that the latter will be the parent vessel on which the above whale catcher will attend. As regards spare gear the vessel may therefore be considered as coming within the category of vessels engaged on short voyages. The proposed arrangements for the spare propeller to be carried by the parent vessel is accordingly submitted for approval.

It is concluded that the combustion chamber stays are rivetted in the shell and nutted in the combustion chambers, but this should be confirmed.
