Dear Sirs,

In our capacity of Insurers of the hull of s/s "EL GAMIL" sunk in Red Sea on the 26th October 1960, we will ask you to kindly clarify us the following points:

- 1) on what grounds the above ship obtained the 100 A 1 classification (your certificate No. 42248 dated 16.2.1960), as against her very old date of built.
- 2) please quote the name of your Suez Marine Surveyor who classified and inspected the ship, principally taking into consideration that in accordance with the Port & Light Administration's Certificate of Survey the cause of sinking is due to "the wear and tear of the ship which through the action of rough weather and bumps of waves against the hull broke the rivets thus causing a gash through the plates".

We shall esteem it a favour if you will let us know the maximum winter load capacity of s/s "EL GAMIL" considering that during the incriminated voyage the consignment was of Metric Tons 2100.- of cement in paper bags.
