"EL GAMIL" (Stated Sunk) 23/10/60

As a matter of interest we enclose a clipping from the newspaper "AL AHRAM" dated 29th October, 1960 Cairo, of which the following is a translation.

"4 Certificates on account of seaworthiness of "EL GAMIL"

"The Owners of the Commercial Storage and Navigation Co. who owns the "EL GAMIL" gave further information. Mr. Mahmoud Abou Aref the member of the board of Directors stated that "EL GAMIL" did not start her voyage until the Master agreed to carry out the services of the Radio Officer. Mr. Mohamad Abdel Moula the Chairman of the board of Directors presented 4 Certificates of Lloyd's London. The 1st states that "EL GAMIL" docked 10.59 and that Mr. Friman was satisfied with her condition. The second dated 11.59 states that the machinery and boilers were in good condition. The third dated 16.2.60 states that the vessel is fully classed. The 4th dated 16.7.60 states that the vessel is good."
