The tank top plating has been increased in thickness under the hatchways in lieu of ceiling.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed ~~as~~ 100A1 "With freeboard" "Fitted for oil fuel 6.45, FP above 150°F" 6.45 Sld. "Carrying cargo oil FP above 150°F in midship deep tank".
