Reverting to your letter of the 27th. instant and to Middlesbrough Report No. 11009 on Engines and Boilers No. 1947 built by Messrs. Blair and Co. Limited, we beg to inform you that these Engines and Boilers will not be fitted in The Societe Espanola de Construcccion Navale's S.S. No. 20, but are to be offered for sale.

We are further informed by the Builders that had the original contract been carried through they would have been responsible for the whole of the fees, but in the present circumstances it is suggested that an account for £50:7:3 should be rendered now. This being the amount charged for the duplicate engines and boilers Nos. 1946 (Middlesbrough report No. 10965), viz:- 4/5ths. fee less the First Entry Fee of £4 charged in that case, We shall be glad to learn that this suggestion meets with approval.
