Dear Sirs,

A. With reference to your letter of the 22nd instant respecting the fee to be charged for the survey during construction of Messrs. Blair & Co's Engines No. 1947 (your report No. 11009) which are intended to be fitted into the s.s. No. 20 building at Bilbao by Messrs. The Societe Espanola de Construccion Navale, I have to inform you that the proportion of the fee due to your port will, in accordance with the terms of Circular No. 1348, be four-fifths of the total fees, the practice now being to include the first entry fee with the Special Survey fee before the fees are divided.

In this case therefore the amount due to your port will be four-fifths of £66:19:0 = £53:11:2, and you will be good enough to render an account to the Engineers accordingly, unless Messrs. Blair & Co., are liable for the whole fee, in which case one-fifth of the total fee will be due to the Bilbao Office, but I shall be glad if you will let me hear from you on this point in order that the Society's Surveyors at Bilbao may be advised in sending the report on to them for their guidance in completing the survey.

You will also be good enough to let me know the date of your application for the fees for entry on your report.
