SOURCE OF INFORMATION

CABO TORINANA. — Gijon, May 5. — Spanish steamer Cabo Torinana, Huelva for Gijon, cargo pitprops, sank off Cabo Busto early on May 4 after collision with Spanish motor tanker CAMPEON owing to fog. One life was lost.
