SOURCE OF INFORMATION

ILHA GRANDE. — Sao Luiz, Mar. 9. — First news received of grounding of tank steamer Ilha Grande, understood via local naval radio. Vessel, fully loaded fuel oil, hard aground 1.15 a.m. to-day, while on voyage from Rio Janeiro to Belem; draught, soundings unreported. Brazilian cargo motor vessel Rio Jaguaribe and motor tanker Espirito Santo arriving on scene to-night and naval corvette Mearim expected a.m., Mar. 10. — Lloyd's Sub-agent per Salvage Association. (See "Tanker Aground near Sao Luiz" in issue of Mar. 10.)

Sao Luiz, Mar. 10. — Brazilian tank steamer Ilha Grande reported aground Manoel Luiz Reef, fully loaded fuel oil, while on voyage from Rio Janeiro to Belem. Vessel stranded at 1.15 a.m., Mar. 9. Understood engine-room, forward pump-room flooded. Nos. 3 and 4 port tanks making water. Crew abandoning ship, being taken off by Brazilian cargo motor vessel Rio Jaguaribe. Brazilian corvette Mearim from Belem arriving to-night view study possibility of salvage.

ILHA GRANDE. — Sao Luiz, Mar. 10. — Tank steamer Ilha Grande: Engine-room and forward pump-rooms flooded and Nos. 3 and 4 port tanks making water; unable to lighten ship. — Lloyd's Sub-agent per Salvage Association. (See issue of Mar. 12.)

Sao Luiz, Mar. 12. — Tank steamer Ilha Grande: Understood abandoned as total loss. Crew being taken to Belem by corvette Mearim. — Lloyd's Sub-agent per Salvage Association.

ILHA GRANDE. — Belem, Mar. 11. — Tank steamer Ilha Grande: Part crew arrived to-day, remainder expected to-morrow. Local agent says ship total loss, but final news from naval corvette awaited. — Lloyd's Agent per Salvage Association. (See issue of Mar. 13.)

Belem, Mar. 13. — Tank steamer Ilha Grande abandoned as a total loss. Brazilian Navy consider impossible to refloat. — Lloyd's Agent per Salvage Association. (See issue of Mar. 14.)
