Enclosed please find print showing modifications and additions to the piping arrangements of the G. "Shahristan" now being converted to oil-burning by Messrs The Walkend Shipway & Engineering Co. Ltd.

The settling tanks shown were approved by the Committee in your letter of the 28<sup>th</sup> ult<sup>o</sup>.

Suitable fire-extinguishing steam-lines are being fitted in the stokehold, controlled from outside the casing top. There is now no connection between pumps which have large suckers and the boilers.

The arrangements generally comply with the section 35 of the 1922-3 Rules and are submitted for the approval of the Committee.
