Nature of Survey

The Newcastle Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated and minor repairs effected.

Alterations have been carried out with a view to oil fuel for burning purposes being carried in the double bottom tanks in way of the holds in accordance with approved plans and to the Surveyors' satisfaction.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 5,23, as recommended.


