Steamer "VALERUNA"

I am informed by the Society's Principal Surveyor for Canada that the Hall Corporation, Montreal, are proposing to purchase this ship, which is due to be dry docked at Casablanca on the 24th instant.

The Hall Corporation are anxious that an exclusive Surveyor to this Society shall be present on that occasion, and as the present Owners have no objection to this course being followed, I have today cabled to the Society's Surveyors at Lisbon, requesting them, if possible, to arrange for one of them to proceed to Casablanca for the desired duty.

It has been explained to the Hall Corporation that this will not be regarded as a Condition Survey with a view to purchase, but purely as a normal Drydocking Inspection for maintenance of class.

It will be appreciated if you will inform the Lisbon Surveyors immediately, should it come to your knowledge that the vessel is not likely to be in dry dock on the 24th instant.
