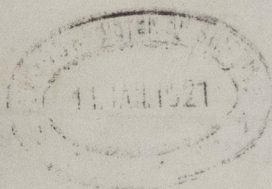

Messrs Marine & Locomotive Superheaters, Ltd of Manchester attend at their Works on the 7th December 1920. for the purpose of testing by hydraulic pressure sixteen pressed steel headers and elements for same intended for Superheaters to the order of Messrs John Brown & Co, Ltd of Clydebank for their Contract No 597.

The pressed steel headers were tested in accordance with the Rules of this Society with satisfactory results.

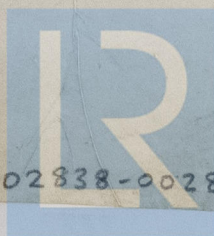
The finished headers were tested in my presence by hydraulic pressure to 645 lbs per square inch and 10% of the elements to 2400 lbs per square inch and found satisfactory.

The headers are numbered:- 185, G. - 8, 9, 12, 15, 16, 18, 21, C.- 7, 10, 12, 15, 19, 29, 30, 37, and are stamped - LLOYDS TEST 645 LBS. with date of hydraulic test and with  for identification.
