## ALTERATIONS TO CONDITIONS OF ASSIGNMENT OF LOADLINES

This ship has been under survey at North Shields

on 11th December, 1956 and the following alterations to the conditions of assignment of loadlines have now been effected/~~found~~UPPER DECK BULWARKS:-

The bulwark plating port and starboard has been extended from the bridge house front forward, to frame 122/3, complete with bulwark rail, stays and stiffeners.

A freeing port 5'-9" x 9" has been fitted above the sheer strake. P+S

The upper deck house aft and house over, have now been renewed with minor modifications to suit accommodation.

Upper deck house of steel strongly constructed, with 2 hinged steel watertight doors in the housefront.

1 hinged steel watertight door at the aft end port and starboard, forming access to steering gear compartment.

1 strong wood door port and starboard.

House on boat deck of steel, strongly constructed with 1 strong wood door port and starboard.

All deckhouse doors have 24" coamings and are able to be manipulated from both sides.


Ventilation of these houses are by the thermo tank system.

The scuppers and sanitary discharges overboard are as fitted originally.
