The case of your motorship "BROWNS BAY" was reported to the Committee today and disappointment was expressed that you had not answered their letter of the 31st May calling for settlement of the outstanding amount of £810. 15. 0. by the 30th June as required.

Before taking the extreme measures set forth in our above mentioned letter they have decided to give you another fortnight in which to pay, but I have to say that if the full amount of the outstanding debt is not received here by Friday, 16th instant, the vessel's class will be expunged from the Register Book with a red line indicating non-compliance with the Rules.

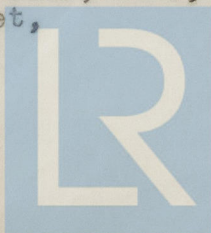
I am also requested to add that non-payment of this account would prejudice the attendance of the Society's Surveyors on other vessels of your fleet unless satisfactory guarantees of prompt payment of fees for classification surveys were forthcoming.
