
m.s. "BROWNS BAY".

It was with much regret I observed that the expectations referred to in your letter of 24th April remain unfulfilled, and that the amount of £810.15.0 outstanding against the m.s. "BROWNS BAY" is still undischarged.

We had therefore no option but to bring the matter to the notice of the Committee, who desire me to say that unless the account is paid in full before 30th June, 1954, they will give instructions for the vessel's class to be dealt with as provided for in Section 24 of the Society's Rules and Regulations.

I must further add that in the event of the vessel being offered for sale, you should inform intending purchasers that the continuance of her class is subject to payment before 30th June, 1954, of the £810.15.0 charged for the major survey held at Kiel in April/October, 1953.
