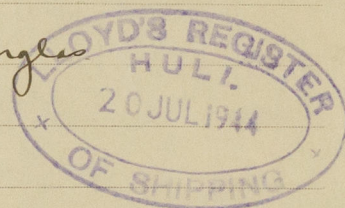
Bulkheads have now been erected in shelter tween decks on frames

No. 43 and 132 from aft.

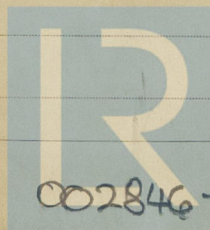
The scantlings are in accordance with Circular 1796c of 12th August, 1942 and Ministry of War Transport M.S.603/42. The bulkhead plating is welded to 2nd deck, and riveted to frames and beams. Drainage is by 3" scupper pipes led to hold bilges (p & s) fitted forward of frame 132 and aft of frame 43.

Bulkheads hose tested on completion and found satisfactory.
