Nature of Survey

The London Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated and on account of damage through grounding and heavy weather, 1 shell plate and 8 fore peak tank semi-box beam lugs have been renewed, 2 shell plates and 3 frames repaired and minor repairs carried out.

A new fuel oil tank has been fitted in No.1 hold in accordance with approved plans.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 11,33.
