

Green & Silley Weir Ltd., of London examine at their works on the 20th September 1933 and subsequent dates two cast iron high pressure cylinders (Lentz type with poppet valves) and examine the machining and afterwards test same by hydraulic pressure 270 lbs., per sq., inch and found the castings tight and sound at that pressure.

Also did examine the following cast steel fittings and test same by hydraulic pressure of 660 lbs., per sq., inch satisfactorily.

- 2 Bulkhead Valves for main engine.
- 1 6" Double valve with branch between.
- 1 8½" Globe valve.
- 5 5½" Globe valves.
- 10 5½" x 5½" x 5" "T" pieces.
- 10 5" Globe valves.
- 10 5" Bends.
- 5 2" Globe valves.
- 5 5" x 5" x 2" x 2" fourway pieces.
- 2 8¼" Offset pieces.
