Green & Silley Weir Ltd., of London examine and test by hydraulic pressure of 660 lbs., per sq., inch the following cast steel parts, intended for the superheated steam system of the twin screw steamer "FORDSDALE" of London, and did find the same to be satisfactory at that pressure.

- 1 5" x 4" x 5" T piece.
- 1 3" x 4" x 4" T piece.
- 1 5" x 3" x 5" T piece.
- 1 4" "U" piece.
- 1 3" Globe valve.
- 1 4" Globe Valve.

The parts have been stamped for identification No.7085 W.H.F. with date of test.

Also four cast iron single flanged pipes fitted with "PMG" metal sleeves shrunk on, intended for H.P. education pipe expansion gland, examined before and after shrinking sleeves and found, as far as can be seen, sound.
